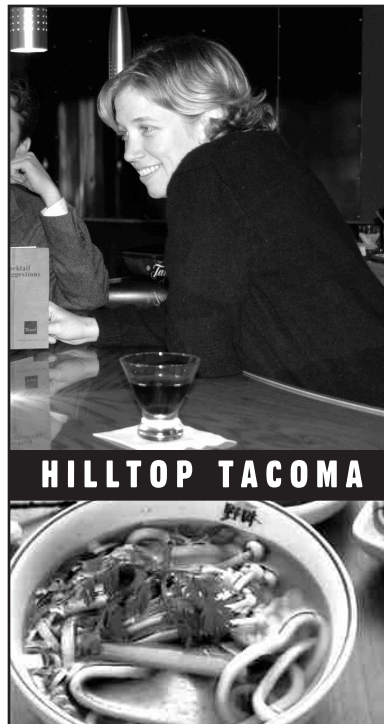




TACOMA
