



Living Smart program takes to the streets

A SUSTAINABLE Streets program will be launched in Peregian on Saturday, June 28, from 2pm, with the Green Sunshine project rallying participants for the Living Smart Homes Program.

Spoonbill St will be the "flagship" destination to pilot the program that aims to sign residents up to Living Smart, which was developed through the former Noosa and Caboolture Councils and aims to encourage communities to take up sustainable living practices in the home.

Green Sunshine is part of the Noosa Creative Alliance's Catalyst program. Spokesperson Christine Ballinger said the concept of sustainability would be applied at the grass roots level.

There will be on-line demonstrations of Living Smart and eco-friendly sample bags. Residents who sign up for the program on the day will receive a free energy saving light bulb, donated by Cetnaj Lighting, Noosaville.
